Greetings Area 46,

As most of you are aware by now, the Secretary of the Department of Health in New Mexico has initiated a Directive that all "Mass Gatherings" of groups of 100 people or more are prohibited.

In light of this Directive, we will not hold our onsite March Assembly in Taos as scheduled for March 27, 28, and 29. After discussion and vote of the Area 46 Officers the current intent is to postpone until sometime in May, pending the developments with the COVID-19 virus. Should the restrictions be lifted by then, the Host District in Taos will re-address the planning and scheduling. We will keep you posted as developments change.

Since this Assembly was also our Pre-Conference Assembly, our Delegate Bill L will schedule a series of Conference Calls to allow Area 46 to participate in the Conference process. The call schedule will be distributed and posted to the Area 46 website and the Delegate's page. Our Delegate will be providing further details in separate communications.

Please know that in these unsettled times, the health and safety of our membership is the highest priority for Area 46 and that we will continually update everyone with the latest information that is available to us.
